Wheeler Family Association Events and Committees

Athletics Spirit Committee and Team Parent Reps

Work with the Athletics director to create engagement opportunities for families around Middle and Upper School sporting events. This is a school-wide committee that meets throughout the year.

Clothing Sale Committee

Help organize the Famous Wheeler Clothing Sale that is held every spring. Volunteer opportunities include assisting on donation days, set up for sale, staffing the sale, public relations and marketing. This is a school-wide committee that meets in the fall and then meets more regularly in the spring, primarily in April.

Enrollment and Welcoming Committee

Faculty and Staff Appreciation Committee

Annual donation drive to support Amos House families during the winter holiday season. This is a school-wide committee that meets in the winter.

Homecoming Committee

Support the school's homecoming events in mid-October, including Family Fall Fest, Fun Run, sporting events, etc. This is a school-wide committee that meets in the fall.

Lost & Found Captains

Help organize the lost and found items and facilitate days to reunite them with their owners. This is a school-wide committee that meets throughout the year.
